Program Components

Worship. We will gather as a community of Filipino/Filipino-American United Methodists to affirm our faith in God and our common bond with each other.

The New UMC Vision, Mission Statement. By the time NAFAUM meets for the 18th Convocation, the new vision and mission statement of The United Methodist Church shall have been released. This would be an opportunity to hear from a leader of the church to expound on this new vision and mission statement.

Business Sessions. Per Article 4, Section 4.01 of the NAFAUM Constitution and By-Laws, NAFAUM gathers to elect the board of directors of NAFAUM and the commissioners of the Filipino Vitality Commission; elect officers for the next biennium; hear the reports of the President, Treasurer, and other committees; adopt the budget; pass appropriate resolutions and motions; and amend by-laws when appropriate.

We will have an online convocation to be held on July 5th to receive reports from the treasurer, and several committees: By-Laws, Nominations, and Resolutions.

Kapihan (World Cafe). Kapihan, or more commonly known as World Cafe, is a methodology for hosting and facilitating large group conversations. There are various cafe tables throughout the venue where small groups of participants can gather and participate in conversations. There are three rounds of conversations where participants will tackle one question for each round. Each round lasts for 15 minutes. After each round, participants move to another table to engage in conversation with other participants.

Another hour will be devoted for World Cafe harvest, which is the term used for processing the result of the conversations in a big group (plenary) setting. Individuals are invited to share key highlights and insights from their conversations.

World Cafe Ministry Plan is a facilitated conversation that processes, distills, and puts together the insights from the World Cafe into the beginnings of a ministry action plan that would help guide the direction of NAFAUM in the coming years. Specific action items and recommendations will be referred to the newly elected officers and/or Filipino Vitality Commission for planning, and implementation.
